

Grande Meadows 2022 BP Open Rules

Welcome to all participants in the 15th Annual Burin Peninsula Open Golf Tournament. We hope that you have an enjoyable day on the course. Good luck with the golf too!

Start

There will be a shotgun start beginning at 8:00am Saturday July 23.

Scorecards

We are asking one player to keep the scores for all group members. Please be sure to check your score at the end of the round to make sure it is correct. We just ask the person keeping score to sign the card.

Bunkers

Bunkers are now raked so you play the ball as it lies. However, golfers are allowed a rollover in the bunker if the ball lands in an unraked footprint as long as it is not embedded in its landing spot.

Conditions of the Competition

The tournament is governed by the Rules of Golf as published by the USGA and the R and A, the Local Rules for the province.

There are 4 Divisions for Men and 1 Ladies Division. This is a stroke play tournament consisting of 2 rounds of 9 holes. The first 9 for Men's Division 1, 2 and 3 is played from the white tees followed by the second 9 played from the blue tees while for Men's Division 4 and Ladies the first 9 is played from the red tees followed by the second 9 played from the yellow tees on Saturday morning, July 23. **Golfers must be on time for Tee Times.**

Local Rules for Grande Meadows

The ball must be putted into the hole – there will be no gimmes allowed. If the ball hits the flagpole and stays out it can't be picked up.

The interior of the course is marked with Red Stakes with Green Tops denoting a Penalty area. This is a sensitive environmental area which Members wish to protect. Players entering this area are subject to **Disqualification**. A Player may stand in the area to play a ball that is not within the Hazard. A **player must take relief** for a ball within the marked area.

A Drop Area for ***Ladies*** is established on Hole #6 and Hole #15 for any tee shot that fails to carry the hazard. It is located to the left front of the green, is clearly marked and is available to the divisions listed above.

A Drop Area for ***Men's Divisions*** is established on Hole #4 and Hole #13 for any tee shot that fails to carry the hazard. It is located to the right front of the old tee box, is clearly marked.

Out of Bounds: For a ball played to the right on hole 8/17 that is LOST or OB, the player can hit a provisional from the spot the last shot was played from or determine the point where the ball crossed the

OB line or was lost and then take a drop with 2 stroke penalty directly across from that point 2 club lengths from the edge of the fairway not far from where the ball entered the tree area.

NOTE: There is **No Relief** from small trees located anywhere on the course.

Ground Under Repair or GUR

Ground Under Repair or GUR is marked with white paint. If any area is GUR players are allowed a free drop within 1 club length no closer to the hole.

Prizes:

Prizes will be given to the top 3 finishers in each Division both Gross and Net.

In case of tie for first in Low Gross in either Division, sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1 and continuing onto hole #2, #3 and so on. Same procedure if there is a tie for Low Gross overall to determine winner of tournament.

In case of tie for Low Net and for all others placings, winners will be decided by the following procedure: best back 9 gross total, best last 6 holes, best last 3 holes gross total and count back from hole # 18.
